Salem Street Bridge Project

Massachusetts Department of Transportation has begun the Salem Street bridge replacement project, which is taking place just southwest of West Cummings Park. The work will reportedly be done in four stages so the bridge can be kept open to vehicle and pedestrian traffic. Drivers can expect some delays during the first phase, which is scheduled to run through the fall. Signs, traffic control devices, and law

enforcement details will be used to guide drivers through the work zone.
