

The city of Woburn is making headway in its efforts to alleviate local traffic around the I-93/I-95 interchange. Its proposed low-cost project will modify the existing I-93 South with a new entrance point from the end of Cedar Street. The breakdown lane will also be converted to a new travel lane. If approved, the project is anticipated to reduce collisions at the overburdened I-93/I-95 cloverleaf and provide additional transport capacity on I-93, environmental benefits (by reducing emissions), and improved commuting times for the residents and employees in Woburn and the abutting communities.
