Winter Overnight and Snow Parking: Please note that winter overnight and snow parking protocols are in place through March 31, 2022. All unattended parking (where the driver is not readily available to move the vehicle) is strictly prohibited in any open parking lot between 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM, unless otherwise approved by Cummings Properties.

When snow is forecasted, or when snow removal operations are necessary, any vehicle left in an open



parking lot after 7:00 PM will be subject to towing at the owner's expense. This policy does not apply to vehicles parked in on-site parking garages.
