The Shoe designed and manufactured nearly all of the major parts in its shoe-making machinery, effectively dominating the world market for this type of equipment. It created more than 300 different machines that could be purchased or leased, depending on a company's needs. The Shoe's research division reportedly registered more than 9,000 U.S. patents over the course of its lifespan.
