# **Shoe Snippets**

Fun facts about the historic Cummings Center site, formerly known as "The Shoe"

In the late 1980s, after the close of The Shoe, the factory belonged to Black & Decker Corporation. Its attempt to convert the factory to an industrial park was unsuccessful and ended with a 90 percent vacancy rate. Black & Decker sold the property in 1996 to Cummings Properties for \$500,000. Today, Cummings Center is a thriving business campus that boasts a more than 90 percent *occupancy* rate.
