Small Businesses Eligible for New COVID-19 Relief Funding



The Baker Administration has allocated \$668 million to a small business COVID-19 relief grant program offered through Massachusetts Growth Capital Corporation (MGCC). Qualifying businesses can apply for up to \$75,000 each in funding to be used for operating expenses such as

utilities, employee wages and benefits, and debt service. Small businesses that applied during MGCC's initial round of funding this past fall need not reapply. New applications will be accepted **until January 15**. [Learn more and apply.](#)

New Woburn Bridge on Track to Reopen:

Woburn's New Boston Street railway bridge is finally moving toward its replacement, with Massachusetts Department of Transportation expected to begin construction in spring 2021. The project will reestablish a road connector between North Woburn and Wilmington (over the MBTA New Hampshire Branch tracks), which was closed in 1978 due to the bridge's poor condition. The venture aims to improve local traffic patterns and access to the area, as the bridge will serve as an alternative route to I-93.
